

ROA Fishing Rules

1. Bass under 3 pounds: “catch and release” only
2. Bass over 3 pounds: can be harvested with a limit of two per day per fisherman.
3. Bream and crappie: a combined total of ten fish per day, per fisherman.
4. NO MINNOW FISHING ALLOWED.
5. ROA identification tags must be displayed by members and guest while fishing. Tags are available to members only at the ROA office for a cost of \$5.00 per tag. Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.
6. Creekside and Mallard Landing residents are permitted to fish Mirror Lake ONLY. Instead of ROA identification tags, Creekside and Mallard Landing residents must have Mirror Lake Fishing identification tags (yellow). Office hours are Monday through Friday 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM.

Hopefully these rules will protect our fish population without restricting our enjoyment of the sport. All good fisherman like a challenge; “catch and release” will make us all better fisherman. The lakes are for our enjoyment; it is our responsibility to protect them.
